am accounted for all men once to die, do make & declare this my last will & testament, that is
to say, I principally first of all, I give & recommend my soul in to the hands of Almighty
God that gave it & my Body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian burial
at the discretion of my executor nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the mighty power of God & esteeming such worldly estate as I possess
it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give & bequeath of the same in the following manner

I first of all I will that all my Just lawful Debts be paid.
 Item I will I bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca Gray all the bed with all the furniture I will also that she have all the dressor & her furniture, I will also that she have all her wheels & also her lock reel, I will also that she have the loom, & also I will that she have my sorrel mare & also that she have her flock of two of the cows & also two sheep, I will also that she have one third of my deeded land, I will also that she have as much allowed her as will get her a new side saddle. I will also that she have the plow & gears.

Item I give I bequeath to my beloved Daughter Zella Gray, & my beloved son James L. Gray all my mortally Estate that remains to be equally divided between them, & also I will that if ever there is a lawful right get for the western Land that I have the Obligation on John Wilson that it be equally divided between those two Children, I will that my son James L. Gray have my silver Watch. And I do likewise constitute make & ordain Thomas Gray & Robert Gray sole Executors of this my last will & Testament I do hereby utterly disavow Revocation, Dissent, all & every other Testaments, wills, bequests, & Executors Ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament.
