I Give a large Bible I to my Grandson Robert McKnight I Give a neg
roid named Solomon All my property not otherwise disposed of I desire
to be sold & the money to be applyed to the following purpose
It is my will that my executors reserve a sum sufficient for the payment
of all my ^{own} & my Deceased husbands Just Debts & apply it to that purpose
I the remainder to be equally divided among the following persons
Elizabeth Muse, Sarah King, John Huggins, Smith, Huston, & Mary Hall

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I Prudence Poir. I do hereby constitute & appoint my son in law John
Huggins & my son Robert to be the executors of this my last will
& Testament I do utterly disallow & disavow all & every other Testa-
ment Will Legacy Bequest & executors by me in any way before now
and will do or Bequeaths Ratifying & confirming this & no other to
be my last will & Testament.

said Sarah Brown as her last Will & Testament in presence of us

Lord one thousand seven hundred eighty seven make & publish this my last will
& Testament in manner following, that is to say first.

with my mansion House & all the improvement where I now live in fee simple
upon this express Condition that my son William pay or cause to be paid the fol-

Thomas twenty pounds, to my son John twenty pounds, to my daughter ~~Elizabeth~~
~~Elizabeth~~ ^{McQuade} twenty pounds to my daughter Sassanna ^{McQuade} twenty pounds
The residue of my estate I Give & bequeath to my four sons only James
Thomas, William, & John to be sold & equally divided among them
I make & ordain my son William Bone & my trusty friend Thomas
Kilpatrick the whole & sole executors of this my last will & Testament utterly
disallowing, revoking, & disannulling all former Wills legacies & bequest by me
