1794 I Walter Bell, of the county of Frederick State of Maryland
Being sick & weak of body but of sound mind & memory willing
to make the mortallity of my body that it is appointed unto man
once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament &
first I pray god to all I recommend my soul to god who gave it
I my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian & decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but I shall receive
the same at the general resurrection by the Almighty power of god
so touching the worldly estate wherewithal I death pleasure god to
help me with in this life I do hereby bequeath & determine to give
you the following manner & formly.

In witness I allow all my just debts & funeral charges to be paid
off my ^{Estate} movable property Item I give & bequeath to Sarah my beloved
wife her old Spinnin wheel & distill & bottle Item I give
the bequeath to my son Isaac two hundred acres of land one of which
he has in his signs for over Item I give & bequeath to my son William
the land that lies between Where James line dover to a small brook
above my clear land with a straight line through the same to the
end of the brook to the same more or less to him her heirs & executors
ever only under the direction of him This last or what is
last to come to his brother David no lands to be left South the

I and to be his brother James for his Care over him. Item I give I bequeath to my son John all the remaining part of my farm with the houses building & every Appertinance there unto belonging or appertain
 ing to him this heire & hissever forever only under & subject to the main
 durance of the mother & small Children to the age sixteen with the
 help of their own Labour & wife the remains a widow with two
 plows one large one small with their Geers one mare & one
 colt & with a blaze face one ox one malleck. Item I give I bequeath
 to my Son Thomas five pounds. Item I give I bequeath to my son
 Peter, five pounds, all the remaining part of my estate further
 to be sold by my executors & equally divided betwix the mother & Geers
 I belonging to my executors & likewise considered Contain S. H. &
 J. Wilson my truly friends to be the Whole & sole Executor of this my
 last will & testement & bearing all other wills legacies or bequests
 & muniments before made or now made ratifying & confirming this
 if no other to be my last will & testement given under my hand
 at Coal Sheddge above written signed sealed & witnessed this
 day in presence of
