to bless me with, I give Bequeath & Dispose of in the following manner
I give First I will & Order all my lawful Debts to be paid also I
give Bequeath to my wellbeloved Wife Peggy one negre woman Ann
& her two Children Silvy & Simon all & singly the household
furniture one Cow & calf to her & during her naturall life or widowhood
then at her Death or marriage the above said Property & increase
of it & grows to be sold at publick vendue & the money equally
Divided betwixt my two Children Evalina & John. Iock also I give
that my Beloved wife Peggy shall take four hundred Dollars of my
Estate to purchase a piece of land for her to Live on the said
Land at her Death or marriage to be divided between my afforsaid
and Children I also will Bequeath one more a sorrel with a black
face & a woman settle to my Beloved Wife Peggy the residue
of my Estate I will Bequeath that it shall be sold & the money
to be equally Divided between my afforsaid Children
that is Evalina & John Iock, & I Do hereby constitute &
appoint my Beloved Wife Peggy to be my Executrix & my true
& trusty Friend Abner Campbell my Executor of this my last will
& Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& the seal of my said County of Iredell this 10th day of
March 1800
