I, J. Allen, Alexander of the County of Fredell in the State of North-Carolina being of sound & disposing mind and <sup>memory</sup> ~~mortality~~ do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form as followeth Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Keincy the free & pleasurable possession of the house in which I now live in and such a part of the Garden & other out houses as she may choose enclosing her natural life. & Also one third part of all my household furniture her choice of any of my horse enclosures that I may be possessed of & any one of my keeping now she may choose & a sufficient maintenance for her self and her creatures to be provided by my son James as long as she lives & also the negre girl ~~Keened Emma~~ to be to her only proper use and she is to be intitled to her services as long as she lives I give & bequeath unto my son William Alexander fifty silver dollars and at the request of my Wife Keincy I give the like sum of fifty dollars to his son John Alexander said moneys to be given his father with the other fifty which I allow him to account with her son for when at the age of twenty one I give to my James Alexander one hundred silver dollars & Also the tract of land of one hundred Acres all ready laid off & named to him description here would be useless as all the family knows it and also the negr boy named George to be delivered to him immediately after my decease. I give & bequeath to my son Zachary Alexander one hundred dollars which he is to retain in his hand out of the two hundred dollars he got from me at parting & like wise disclaim any right to the land he gave me a power to sell for him & repay my self out of the price of it. & as I intend to put into his hand a full power to ask demand & in my name to ~~recover~~ recover a certain negro boy named Bob now in the possession of my son in law James Sloughston which said negro Bob I absolutely deny ever having exchanged my property or right to in any manner whatsoever & on the recovery of said negro he is then to remit to my son William the other hundred dollars as

The other as mentioned on the other side but if it so happens or  
 so turns out that she does not get said negro then and in that case he is  
 not to pay the above money nor is she in any wise to be accountable to my  
 heirs or executor for it. I Give & bequeath to my son David Alexander the  
 negro girl Tecan & Also one hundred silver dollars to be paid him by my  
 executor as soon as convenient after my decease. I Give & bequeath to  
 my son Allen Alexander all that part of my land that I now possess  
 and is connected with my present dwelling being to the west & South of a  
 marked line this morning by my self his brother Moses & himself beginning  
 at a pine mark as a corner in a line of land I gave to my son Saml  
 and from thence a straight course to the North corner of the field  
 known by the name of the upper field & from thence a straight course to the  
 North corner of the second field over the branch opposite to my present  
 dwelling and along the lower fence of said field to the eastern corner  
 & from the corner of said field a straight <sup>course</sup> crossing the creek to a  
 black oak marked this day as a corner in the south line of the  
 old tract I likewise give and bequeath to him my two negro boys  
 Yemie one Ben & the other Abram & the negro girl Tecan and  
 one third part of all the stock of horses Cattle Hogs & Sheep that  
 I may be at that time possess of Also one third part of all my  
 household furniture to be given to him at the discretion of his mother  
 likewise my debt & one third of all the ready money notes & outstand-  
 ing debts that I may be possess of at the time of my decease after all  
 bequeathments & other contingencies is well settled. I Give & bequeath to  
 my son Stoves Alexander all their remainder of my land & possessive  
 not hereof bequeath to my wife Nancy or son Stov consisting of my  
 present dwelling with all the improvements & Appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging Also one third part of all my ready money  
 notes of hand & outstanding debts that may remain after the bequeath-  
 ments & other contingencies are settled & likewise the Negro  
 man Gabriel & the two boys Peter & Belle & Also the girl Emma  
 he is to have at his mothers death but not before without her  
 consent he is likewise to have all the remainder of my stock of horses  
 Cattle Sheep & hogs & my residue after the bequeathments
