State of North Carolina, Fredell County, 26th November 1808
Know ye that I Andrew Freeland of said County being near
of body, but of sound mind and memory do make this my
last Will and Testament in the following manner.
First I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Freeland all that part
of land on which he now lives, containing 11 1/2 Acres as being
off to him the his heirs & assigns for ever. Item. I give likewise
to my son Andrew & Freeland all my land on the east side of
Cannon, lying North of Thomas' land the course of the
Branch continued to the old line at the head of said branch,
to his heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give likewise to my son
James & Walter Freeland all my land lying on the south
side of the Cannon River, which I purchased from Genl.
Wilpatrick to be equally divided between them, to them & their
heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give likewise to my son Samuel
all the land which I purchased of Joseph Wilpatrick, lying
near the bridge last mentioned near the South River, to him
& his heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give & bequeath to my
son William & Alexander the Plantation whereon I
now live & 100 Acres of land joining the same which I
purchased of Genl. W. Henry to be equally divided
between them, to them & their heirs & assigns forever.
Item. I give to my son William G. He^r all the
Plantation implements including the Wagon & Cows.
Item. I give to my Daughter Annas her Bed & furniture
one hundred & fifty Dollars. Item. I give to my daughter
Mary, Martin one hundred Dollars, to her & her heirs.

Item.

Now I give to my Daughter Christian my Yearling
Black Coll, the Loom & stockings, one Hundred Dollars
and a Bed & furniture. All the Cattle, Hogs & Sheep
which are not disposed of I give to William, Alexander,
Annas & Christian, & the remainder of the Household
furniture & Dresser affairs to be divided among them.
All the remainder of my Estate not mentioned I wish
and order to be equally divided ~~between~~ among my Sons
James, Walter, Samuel, William & Alexander &
my Daughters Annas & Christian.

I hereby constitute my Sons William & Alex^r
Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
