make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner

Expences & lawful debts is paid, & if any of my present Children
should decease before ^{at} ~~their~~ age the dividore that might

& my debts on debts of my Wife to be equally allotted
Among my Sons the negroes now my property viz. Feb. I. Swain
to be kept on my plantation for the assistance of raising & supporting
and for the life outliving this my last will
of my family. I do hereby appoint my Beloved Father in law

Andrew Neill & my brother James to be my lawful Executors
& I do hereby publish this & no other to be my last will & Testament
