

In the presence of God. I MEMOR this the 22nd day
of February 1807. I, Harrah Gallen of Fredell County
State of North Carolina, being weak in Body, of sound mind
memory, and calling to mind the mortality of my Body, do
make this my last Will and Testament in manner here
following. Viz: I gave unto my Daughter, Nancy, one
Negro Girl, Parkey. I gave unto my Daughter, Isabella
one Negro Girl, Luce. I gave unto my Daughter
Sally, one Negro Girl, Will. I gave unto
Son Benjamin, one Negro man, Digh. I gave unto
Son James, one Negro Boy, Isaac. I gave unto my
Daughter Patsy one Negro Girl, Bettha, and I gave
\$100.00 to make her Negro equal with the rest. I gave
unto my Daughter Polly one Negro Boy, Will. I gave
unto my Daughter Patsy one Negro Boy, Isabella.
I gave unto my Daughter Nancy one Negro Girl,
Luce. I gave unto my two Sons Joseph & Thomas
my Plantation whereon I now live to be equally divided between
them by two men chosen by my executors, which division
of property to take place at the Marriage of my beloved
Wife. I give unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth, my Plantation
whereon I now live, with all the rest residue of my Estate which
not disposed of, during her natural life or widowhood, or her
death, or should it please her to enter into a second Marriage, she
be equally divided between my five youngest Children, that is to
say Thomas, Polly, Patsy & Luce, except the Plantation which
be divided as above between my Sons Joseph & Thomas. Last
I do order ordain constitute & appoint my beloved Wife Elizabeth
my Executrix, and my friend Benjamin Gallen my Co-
executor to this my last Will & Testament, to execute all
former Wills heretofore made. Ratifying & confirming

To be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof

State of North Carolina, Fredell County, 26th November 1808
Know ye that I Andrew Freeland of said County being weak
of body, but of Sound mind and memory do make this my
last Will and Testament in the following manner.
First I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Freeland all that part
of land on which he now lives, containing 311¹/₂ Acres as being
left to him & his heirs & assigns for ever. Item. I give & devise
to my son Andrew Freeland all my land on the East side of
Canaan, lying North of Thomas land the course of the
Branch continued to the old town at the head of said Branch,
to his heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give & devise to my sons
James & Walter Freeland all my land lying on the South
side of the Cathine River, which I purchased from End:
Richdick to be equally divided between them, to them & their
heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give & devise to my son Samuel
all the land which I purchased of Joseph Richdick, lying
near the land last mentioned near the South River, to him
his heirs & assigns forever. Item. I give & bequeath to my
son William & Alexander the Plantation whereon I
now live & 100¹/₂ Acres of land joining the same which
I purchased of John McHenry to be equally divided
between them, to them & their heirs & assigns forever.
Also I give to my sons William & John all the
Plantation implements including the Waggon & Cart.
Item. I give to my Daughter Annas her Bed & furniture
and all the rest of my Estate.
