Now I also give & bequeath to my beloved Grandson Charles two small pieces of Land on the waters of the broad meadow branch going in the buffellow Shole Creek containing one hundred Acres ~~divided~~^{divided} in my name to be wholly at his Disposal when he comes of age providing his Father do not see cause to sell it before that time & in case he does the price that it may be sold for to be kept for his ^{use} in order to give him learning or otherwise laid out for his use.

And in testimony of this my last Will & Testament I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 23rd Day of September 1802.
