wearing apparel & Ten pounds in Cash.

3^d To my well beloved son Joshua Nelson the sum of five shillings

4th To my well beloved son, Jeremiah Nelson I Give I bequeath the
whole in remainder of all my Estate real & personal I do grant
devise I bequeath the same to his own proper use & behoof.

Lastly I do constitute I appoint David Caldwell my sole Executor
who he hereby doth I do appoint as Executor with full power
made acknowledging this & this only to be my last will & Testament
