ment, Viz: Principally, I give my soul into the hands of god who
gave it nothing doubting but at the last Day I shall receive the same
by the power of god & my body I recommend to the Earth to be
buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Exors.
And as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased god to lay
me with in this life I do give & Dispose of the same on the day I man-
ifest following.

1st I do bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret Hill one bed & furniture
such as she shall choos likewise all my kitchen furniture to be dis-
tributed at her pleasure she shall have two cows three sheep, two
saddles & her choice of any one of my hoes & creatures, likewise she shall
have her maintenance of my plantation & the use of the house in
the continuance in the ^{edison} ~~edison~~ she is left in.

2nd As my beloved son James Hill has received his quantity of land I do
further bequeath to him one bed & furniture likewise all the tools
he hath in his possession for the usual right business.

3rd Likewise I do give & bequeath unto my beloved son John Hill the plantation
on which I now live likewise all my farming utensils my waggons &
the furniture.

4th I do give & bequeath unto each of my beloved Daughters Mary, Mar & Har-
riet a bed & furniture a spinning wheel & a saddle, likewise I bequeath my
Personal Property shall be equally divided among them by two of my
Sons such as they shall choose

And do constitute & ordain my loving sons James & John Hill my

all former wills or testaments by me made, testifying & confirming that
no other to be my last will & testament in witness hereof I thereunto set my
hand & affixed my seal this twenty seventh day of August in the year of
