testament that is to say, principally I first of ^{all} I give & recommend my soul
unto the hands of God that gave it & for my body I recommend it to the earth
to be buried in a Christian like & Decent manner at the Discretion & Expence
not doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God touching such worldly estates & other matters
it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same
in the following manner I give first of all of my worldly ^{estate} I bequeath
I bequeath such a part as will discharge all my just & lawful Debts I bequeath
I bequeath my beloved & beloved wife (whom I make executrix) I bequeath her to
have her lawful part of the moveable estate in the next place I give
unto my son Joseph (whom I make sole Executor) & my son Benjamin
this tract of Land I now live on including the Mills, to be & forever
divided between them no way to be controul'd. Next I give to my son
the half of that tract of Land he now lives on & the other half of said
Land I bequeath & dispose of to my son Isaac. In the next place I give
to my Daughter Sally one horse & saddle worth twenty five shillings
two cows to hold as her lawful property. Next to my daughter Sarah
I bequeath one cow. Likewise to my Daughter Elizabeth I bequeath five shillings
I bequeath my beloved son John Tuller five shillings. Likewise unto my
son, the I bequeath five shillings. I do hereby utterly disavow

ament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the
