State of N. Carolina } M. Cullock as his last will & Testament
are as follows (Viz). —————

First I give & bequeath to my loving son John M. Cullock a
Tract of Land in South Carolina on Little River containing 1st
Acres Also a young mare known by the name of Kate to him &
his heirs forever. Secondly I give & bequeath to my Son Lewis
G. Andrew Two Tracts of Land lying on back creek to be equally
Divided between them, the division to be made when my son Lewis
is of Age by men nominated by him & my Executors to them & their
heirs forever. Likewise give my Son Lindsay a young mare

known by the name of Fly. & my best Suit of Clothes.
Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son James a Tract of Land lying
near Statesville containing 320 Acres to him & his heirs forever.

Also I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Margaret her
bed & furniture her saddle & bridle & her Spinning Wheel.

Also that part of my Dwelling House ~~where~~ where the fire place is
nearest of the plantation during her natural life or so long
as she thinks proper to live there, the Chief part of the House
& her half of the plantation to be appropriated to the use of my
Two Daughters Viz Mary & Elizabeth & after my wife's decease
the whole tract to be sold & the price thereof to be equally divided
between my said Daughters Also that

I further Order that my negro Wench Dinah I and my person-
al Estate not bequeathed Above be sold & the whole residue to
be equally divided among the Legatees.

Lastly I Do constitute & appoint my son John McCulloch John
Nisbet & Samuel Fleming Executors of this my last Will & Testament
I Do revoke & Disannul all former Wills & Testaments by me made & I
Do publish pronounce & Declare this my last Will & Testament In
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 10th Day of
Oct^r: 1791. I likewise ordain that Each of my four sons have as much of
the thick cloth reserved as will make a Suit of Clothes of each piece
Signed & Sealed in presence of.
