In the name of God Amen November 2nd 1790
Margaret Albee of the County of Iredell being Sick & weak in
body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God, therefore
calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it
is appointed for all men once to die do make & declare this my Last
Will & Testament (that is to say) principally I give & bequeath
and my soul unto the hands of almighty God who gave it & my body
I recommend ^{to the} my Soul & Earth to be buried in a Decent Christian burial
at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at

the general resurrection. ~~that~~ ^{the} same againe by the
mighty power of God I as touching such worldly estates whereunto
it has pleased God to bless me in this life I as the principal part
of my Estate being in a peace or parcel of Land lying in the
State of Pennsylvania in Tuscarora Settlemente granted by warrant
to Robert McKee I as the said Robert McKee, has received full Satis-
faction as a legatee of his Father said McKees Landed Estate in
Lancaster County I as I was left Sole Executor of said Estate,
I exchanged a part of that landed Estate for the above mentio-
ned land on Tuscarora I as I had his word as a son to a mother
that he would make the property to any more I should, I had
made sale of said land to my son John McKee, & all obligations
I received is carried off by him or his heirs as I suspect I have
received no satisfaction for the said Land to the great disappoint-
ment of my other Children. I declare all other gifts grants, devise
to him or any other person to be void to all intents & purposes &c.
The first place I order the land to be made sale of to the best
Advantage I after all ^{lawfull} Contracts & funeral Expences are discharge
I bequeath to my son Moses Potts & the heirs of my son said McKee
each five Shillings Yearly & the remaining part part to
be equally divided among my other Children (viz) Robert, John,
& William McKee I to my sons by law Samuel Reed, William Sin-
gerton, James McKnight, I order said McKnight, John McKee, to see
this my last will & Testament to be put in Execution.
