my just debts are to be paid. Item 1st I give & bequeath to my four da-
ughters Rebecca Cook, Sarah Willson, Ann Cook & Jean Cook, all my
wearing apparel to be equally divided among them Santity & Quantity
Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my daughter Ann Cook one feather bed
& furniture. Also to my daughter Jean Cook I give & bequeath one feather
bed & furniture for the use of her daughter Polly Cooke. Also I give &
bequeath one feather Bed & furniture to my grand daughter Sally
Coke daughter of John Cooke. Item the 3rd I give & bequeath to my
daughter Rebecca Cooke my Chest. Item 4th I give & bequeath to my
daughter Sarah Willson my folding Table Item 5th I give & bequeath
to my daughter Jean Cooke my saddle & bridle & what of
my Cupboard furniture that is not otherwise bequeathed my trunk.
Item 6th I give & bequeath to Benjnⁿ McConnell's children my right
& Interest I may have in my Clock Item 7th I give & bequeath to my
two Grand sons Jn^r L. McConnell & Samuel W. McConnell to each of
th^e 1/2 of the land that I bought of John W. McConnell in 1808

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to my daughter Jean Cooke my saddle & bridle & what of
my cupboard furniture that is not otherwise bequeathed & my trunk.
Item 6th. I give & bequeath to Benjⁿ McConnells children my right
& Interest I may have in my Clock Item 7th. I give & bequeath to my
two grand sons J^r. L. M. Connell & Samuel W. M. Connell to each of
them ten dollars to be applyed by my executors to purchase cloathing
for them Item 8th. I give & bequeath unto my son my son Benjⁿ.
McConnell my small walnut Breakfast Table. Item 9th. I give
& bequeath to my daughter in law Jean M. Connell my arm Chair
& the five ~~large~~ ^{large} Trunks. Item 10th. I give & bequeath unto my grand
daughter Charity Davidson my cupboard & 5 Pewter Plates & 1 small pewter
Bason. Item 11th. It is further my will & desire that my old
negro man Panny shall be free at my death & that my son Benjⁿ.
McConnell & John Cooke be his guardians & see that no person does
wrong him. Item 12th. It is further my will & desire that my negro
wench Marge my stock of Cattle Hogs & all other kinds of stock
& property of every kind I may be possessed of at my death not already
disposed of or bequeathed shall be sold by my executors at public
Sale & the monies arising from said sale after paying all my just
debts to my funeral charges & all the bequeathments in this my last will

I Testament the balance left to be divided into three equal shares & each of my three daughters, Rebecca Cooke, Sarah Wilson & Jean Cook to receive each an equal share or one third of said monies ~~success~~ And Lastly I do make ordain & appoint my trusty friends Alexander Terrence my executor of this my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Mary M. Cornell have to this my last will & Testament set my hand & Seal the Day & Year above written
