In the name of God Amost this 23rd of April
in the year of Lord 1777 I Mary McTellard, of the County of Rowan,
State of North Carolina being Sick & Weak of body but of perfect mind
I memory thanks be to God: Calling unto mind the mortallity of my
body I knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make
and ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say principally
First of all I give & recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty
God. My body I recommend to the earth, to be buried and disposed
Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God: And as touching such worldly estate wherewith
it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise & dispose of the
same in the following manner & form.

First, I give & bequeath to my loving son Wm McTellard all my Estate
Real & personal to him & his heirs forever Only the leg~~acy~~^{ees} hereafter
Bequeathed that is to say.

I give & bequeath to my son John McTellard one negro boy named
Augy & one hundred Pounds lawful money of this State to him

I his heirs forever.

1800-1808 I give & bequeath to my daughter Rachael

my best Mare, together with the half of all my household furniture
 Also ^{the} half of all the Cotton, yarn, flax, & wool, to her & her heirs forever.
 Likewise give & bequeath to my daughter Rebekah McLellan one negro

girl named Bell to her and her heirs forever.

Likewise give & bequeath to each of my other Daughters (viz) Mary
 Stevenson Agness Stevenson Elizabeth Nisbet Sarah & McCornell & Jean Steven
 son five pounds lawful money of this State together with all my wear
 ing Clothes to them & their heirs forever.

And Lastly I do constitute & appoint my son James McLellan, John
 Nisbet, Executors of this my last will & Testament. And I hereby
 revoke, & disannul, all former wills & Testaments by me made. & I do
 publish prouerence I declare this to be my last will & Testament in
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day of
 Year above written.
