whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me in this life
I give devise dispose of the same in manner & form as follows
and that is to say in the first place I give & bequeath
to my beloved Wife Jane Campbell, all my Land
Immovable property and my Widowhood then to
be sold & be equally divided between my Children, that
is to say Colin Campbell, Mary, Isabella, Jane, Martha,
Catherine, Missilla, Nancy, & likewise constitute me
to contain my only & sole Executor of this my last Will
& Testament my Wife Jane, John Woodsides & I
do hereby disavow revoke & disannul all former Wills
instruments, Wills, Testaments, bequests & Executors by me made
before this time named Willed & bequeathed. Ratify
& confirming this & no other to be my last Will and
