Division to be made of ~~the~~ ^{my} Goods Chattels Houses Lands & Rements &
She is to have the one half at her own disposal & the other half is to be
equally divided between James Hughes my brother son & John
Caven my sisters son to them & their Heirs forever & if the said John Hughes
chose to marry I desire that my after named Executor may take

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 a last inventory of real estate then possessed of I that the one half
 of the same may be made secure for the use of the s^r. James Hough
 Patrick Ervin as above mentioned but the use of the same not to be
 taken out of the s^r. Ann Houghs Hands or Possession During
 her Natural Life I constitute I appoint my s^r. Wife G. Musenden
 Matthew Ezz. Executors of this my Will Continued In Writings Whereof
 I the s^r. Patrick Hough have to this my last will & Testament set
 my hand & seal the Day & year above Written.
