In the name of God amen. I Samuel Tarr of N^c Carolina
being weak of body but of sound mind & memory & calling to mind
the mortality of my body do make this my last will & Testament &
first of all. Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Gemma
Tarr all my lands whereon I now live it being in two tracts one
containing two thousand & forty acres by deed from Wm M Knight the
other containing thirty two acres by deed from David M Knight
lying & being in Fredell County on the waters of Third Creek also two
beds & furniture one horse Colt two years old called Jumper also
seven Dollars due me from Wm. Tomster & eight dollars more
to be raised out of my property the last money to buy her a side sad-
dle to her & her heirs forever Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter
Rachel Tarr all my land on the ridge between the waters of Elk
Shoal & Third Creeks near Rott. Meredith also one negro man
called Abraham for the term of seven years the negro to be hired
out for the term & the hire to be applied to the support & educa-
-tion of my daughter Rachel & at the end of seven years to be
forever free from slavery but the first years hire to be applied

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towards paying my debts I give unto my son Sam^r one negro man by the name of Caleb to be annually hired but the first years hire to go towards paying my just debts & six years hire to be applyed to the schooling of my son Samuel & after Caleb has been hired for seven years, I leave him the said Caleb to be forever free from slavery. I also give unto Samuel one bed & furniture & at the age of 14 years old my son Samuel Sam to be bound apprentice^{my} to J^r W^m Merchant Statesville & D. W^m to learn him the art of trading in merchandize & Book-keeping as far as he is capable. Item, I give Rachel Samone Bed & furniture. I also leave my lands whereon I now live to be rented annually till she becomes of lawful age or married & the first years rent to be applyed towards paying my just debts & but one year at a time not land to be planted in Indian Corn & as much of the rent of land as my executors thinks necessary to be laid out for the support of Samone Sam. and the overplus to be paid unto her at lawful age.

Item, I give unto my loving Wife Sarah Sam peaceable home in one room of my House with Wood Water Garden &c or a small comfortable House built on my land near my peach orchard with kitchen

applied towards paying my debts but one year at a time not
land to be planted in Indian corn was made off the rent of D. land as
my executors thinks necessary to be laid out for the support of Fennema
Tarr. and the overplus to be paid unto her at lawful age.
I then, I give unto my loving Wife Sarah Tarr peaceable home in
one room of my House with Wood Water Garden &c or a small comfort-
able House built on my land near my peach orchard with Kitch-
ing & Kitchen House by Fennema or out of her profits & the use of
of all the land between the branch & the curren up to the line from
the plantation during her widowhood & when she is married she
has no more write to my lands. I also leave all my property not yet
given away after all my just debts is paid to be equally divided betw
my wife Sarah Tarr Rachel Tarr & Saml Tarr to them & their heirs
forever. I also desire I leave my daughter Fennema Tarr to live with
Johnathan M Church & his wife Eloy Church & to be under their care
till she is of lawful age. I also constitute & appoint Majr Matt-
hews Esq. Thomas Morrison Sen. & Walter Jr Morrison jointly
executors of this my last will & testament.
