

Will of Alexander Averyt

In the name of God Amen I Alexander Averyt of Johnston County
and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind
and memory for which I am thankful to Almighty God do make
and ordain this my last will and testament in the following manner

Item First I lend to my beloved wife Sarah Averyt the use of all my lands
and plantation that I possess on Swift Creek during her natural
life and after her death to be disposed of as is herein after
expressed also the use of five negroes (to wit) Isaac, Esther,
Olive and Lucy and Samer during her natural life and after
her death to be disposed of as is herein after expressed. Also the
use of two feather beds and furniture two chests two tables
two trunks her choice all of my setting chairs with all my
bowl and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils. Also no horse
or mare her choice three cows and calves two cows and pigs
during her natural life and after her death to be disposed of
as is herein after expressed.

Item I give and bequeath to my aforesaid wife one year's support
for her and family out of the crop stock and provision on hand.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Averyt one negro boy
named Sam and fifty dollars in cash to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Ingram twenty
five dollars cash to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Christine Baucan twenty
five dollars in cash to her and her heirs forever. Also lend
to my aforesaid daughter the use of two negroes named
Denny and Händy during her natural life and after her
death the same negroes and their increase if any to be
equally divided among her children to them and their heirs
forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son ^{Alexander} Averyt after the death of
my wife all my lands and plantations that I possess
lying on Swift Creek containing by estimation three hundred
and seventy five acres to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Peggy Smith
twenty-five dollars in cash to her and her heirs forever.
Also lend to my aforesaid daughter one negro girl named
Phoebe during her natural lifetime and after her death

said negro and increase if there is any to be equally divided
among her children to them and their heirs forever.

I give and bequeath after the death of my aforesaid wife
to my two grand children Alexander Morris and Harry Ingram
one negro girl named Olive to them to be equally interested
in said negro and her increase if any to them and their
heirs forever. It is my further will and desire that after
the payment of my just debts and other necessary charges
all the balance of my estate both real and personal which
is not above willed or given away to be sold by my executors
herein after named agreeable to law and the money arising
therefrom together with the debts due me

Item I give and bequeath it to all my grand children to be
equally divided to each of them and equal share alike
to all them that may exist at the time of my death to
them and their heirs forever.

Also after the death of my wife all that I loaned to
her during her natural life which is not above willed
away to be sold agreeable to law and after the necessary
charges being paid out of the money arising therefrom the
balance I give and bequeath to all my ^{grand} grandchildren
who may exist at the time of my decease to each of them
equally alike share to them and their heirs forever.
And lastly I do hereby constitute and ordain my son
Alexander Averyt and my friend Edwin Smith executors
to this my last will and testament working and
making void all other wills or bequests by me heretofore
made and ratifying this and only this to be my last
will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal the 16 day of December 1818

last will and testament
