

the road S 57 Wt-11 poles to a small hickory on the south edge of the road Barnabas comes then with his line 251 poles to a post oak in an old field the corner then with his other line S 83 Wt-80 poles to a stake, and small pine by the fence the corner then down a bottom with the other line S 60 Wt-113 poles to a pine the corner then his other line S 1 Wt-155 poles to a maple his corner on the run of Mile Branch (about 50 yards below the big (fall or ford) then down the meander of the mile branch to the mouth of the hog pen branch then up the run of the hog pen branch as it meanders to the first station (containing 374 acres) also I give to the said Bowden Grantham one horse bridle and saddle of the value of eighty dollars by the opinion of my executor hereafter named also his bed & furniture.

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Ally Farris one negro girl named Novenda and her increase to her the said Ally her heirs and assigns forever also I give to my said daughter Ally Farris all the property that I have heretofore given her also one half of a negro girl named Fillas.

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Dicey Grantham one negro girl named Maliza and her increase to the said Dicey her heirs or assigns forever also I give to the said Dicey the other half of negro girl Fillas also one bed & furniture one iron & gear one chest and twenty dollars in money.

Seventhly My will and desire is that all the residue & balance of my property not heretofore above given away to be sold by my executors on a six months credit & the money arising from the sale thereof after paying all my just debts legally decided between my five children namely Barnabas, Ally Whitley, Dicey and Bowden to them and their heirs or assigns forever.

Lastly I constitute nominate and appoint my thirty friend Bowden Grantham (my son) executor to this my last will & testament disannulling and making void all other wills & testaments by me made ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Frederick Grantham hath hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day of - signed, sealed & acknowledged in the presence of - interlined with the words his heirs or assigns forever in the 14 line.
