Calling to mind the great mortality of men and for the better settling of my temporal affairs do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following.

Mys— First I give my soul to God who gave it to me and my body to be buried in a decent order at the discretion of my Executors.

Item I give to my Brother Joseph Gurley three Cows and Calves and a tract of land containing two hundred acres and eight two year old hogs.

Item I also give to my Brother Joseph Gurley two breeding Ewes and two Lambs of Lambs.

Item I give to my Brother Nathan Gurley a seven year old Horse and a rifle Gun and five two year old Hogs.

Item I give to Alexander Pool half a barrel of Corn and a new basket.

Item I give to my master in law two Chests.

Item I give to my Brother Nathan Gurley my Coat, Jacquet and breeches and a narrow hat.

And lastly I appoint my Brother Joseph Gurley and Nathan Gurley my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and testament revoking all other wills or Wills heretofore by me made.

Item I give my eldest son Arthur Gurley a plantation whercon I now live containing One Hundred and Twenty five acres and a dictionary book.

Item I give my beloved son Robert the Lower plantation situated by the Ballard plantation.

Item I give to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Gurley four head of cattle at William Edwards and also a large Church Bible.

Item I give my beloved Daughter Sarah Gurley a mare and all running in the woods at large and also a feather bed and furniture.

Item And all the residue and rest of my Estate goods and chattels

I lend to my beloved wife Anna Gurley during her life or widow hood and then after paying all my lawful debts I give the remainder of all after my wifes decease or widow hood to be equally divided between my four children Nathan Gurley, Robert Gurley, Elizabeth Gurley and Sarah Gurley to be equally directed.

I nominate constitute and appoint my friend William Gurley my Executor of this my last will and testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made testifying this and no other to be my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 9th day of July in the year of our Lord 1776.
