

Will of Edith Folsom

In the name of God Amen. I Edith Folsom of the County of Johnston in the State of North Carolina being in perfect health and of sound mind, and memory blessed be God do this day make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say,

- Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son William Bagan the sum of five shillings current money to him and his heirs and assigns forever.
- Item I give unto my son Samuel Bagan five shillings current money to him and his heirs and assigns forever.
- Item I give to my son Medham Bagan two negroes named, Pollidore and Fillis, one breeding mare by the name of Linnis one feather bed, and furniture three cows and calves and two hogs to him and his heirs and assigns forever.
- Item I give to my beloved daughter Barbara Macey five shillings current money to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give to my daughter Edith Folsom five shillings current money to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give to my daughter Selah Watkins five shillings current money to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Allford five shillings current money to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Esther Bagan five shillings current money to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Bagan one feather bed and furniture two cows and calves, and hogs to her and her heirs forever and all the rest and residue of my goods and chattles after all my just debts and funeral charges being paid to be equally between my two youngest children Medham and Amy Bagan and I do constitute and appoint my loving brother Samuel Smith executor to this my will and testament utterly revoking and disannulling all other and

former wills and bequest by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and seal this 29th of July 1791 signed sealed pronounced, and delivered by said Edith Folsom as her last will and testament.
