be the last will and testament of Zilpha B. McKinney deceased

And thereupon the said John B. Beckwith and Ashley Sanders
executors as aforesaid duly qualified as such by taking
the oath required by law.

In the name of God Amen. I Edward Powers of Johnston County
being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory
blessed be god for it. First I give my soul to god that goes in
hoping through the merits of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
to be with him in his heavenly Kingdom. Secondly I direct my
body to be decently buried my debts and my funeral charges paid
and discharged. Item I give to my Grand daughter Sarah Higdon after
the death of her Grand mother my dwelling plantation whereon I now
live with all the land and appurtenances to the same belonging
together with three cows and a heifer marked with a number
seal under each ear to go with them in Creek and one grey mare branded
with a P Comely known by the name of Sarah Higdon mare and one bid
and furnish the morsables to be delivered to her at the day of marriage
or at her full age. Item I leave to my daughter Sarah Higdon
during her life time one bay natural pony mare with a colt by
her foal and a boy trotting mare with a colt by her sire and
one boy horse about 3 years old cut and does all branded
thus P together with a good decent side saddle and
gives and bequeath her forty dollars Virginia money
Item I give and bequeath to Mary Powers my wife
beloved wife all the rest of my morsable estate both
personal with a pescable person & the plantation
whereon she now lives. During her life time and after
my wife I appoint her to be the sole and sole Executor
of this my last will and testament given under my
hand and seal this 5th day July Anno Domini 1749
