

Will of Elizabeth Garner

In the name of God Amen, I Elizabeth Garner of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being in a low state of health of body but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and testament at the same time utterly revoking all former wills or will by me made declaring this to be my last will and testament which is as follows viz.

First- I give and bequeath to my beloved son Asa Garner one feather bed and furniture also one painted chest and also one stock of sheep which is at Betsy Johnsons also one pewter dish

Secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah Garner two feather beds and furniture and one chest also one stock of sheep at Thomas Browns also one pewter basin

And lastly I give and bequeath to my beloved brother Austin Hatcher all my growing crop of all kinds and I do at the same time appoint him the said Austin Hatcher and Robert Hatcher executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirty-first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-four.

Will of Tobias Godwin

I Tobias Godwin of the county of Johnston and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and knowing that my earthly existence must soon terminate do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say

I give and devise unto my wife Cressey Godwin one third part of my house tract of land to be laid so as to include my mansion house to have and to hold to her the said Cressey Godwin for and during the term of her natural life or widowhood in satisfaction for and in lieu of her dover and third of and in all my real estate. I also give my said wife one bed bedstead and furniture one bay mare two cows and calves ten good fat hogs fifteen bushel of corn three dishes and two basins four bowls six plates one case of knives and forks six chairs all the castings or fat mares five blades stacks six ewes and lambs and all the corn fodder.

I give and devise to my youngest son Tobias Turner Godwin all the tract of land purchased by me of the ~~Heoms~~ about seven hundred and thirty two acres being the same wherein my dwelling house stands except the life estate of my wife devised in the preceding items of this my last will and testament and that part loaned to her during her life time or widowhood. I also give and devise to my said son Tobias Turner to have and to hold to him and his heirs in fee simple forever after her demise or marriage

Item I give to my son Merritt fifty dollars in money.

Item I give and devise unto my son Nevil-Wright-Washington Godwin five hundred and fifty acres of land being the same purchased by me of Eli Garner and William Neiman to have and to hold to him and his heirs in fee simple forever

Item I give my son Griffis one dollar in money

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Amanda Hayes one dollar in money.

Item I give Godfrey Stansel children one dollar in money.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ceciuth Godwin one bed bedstead and furniture and ninety dollars in money.
