

Will of Elizabeth Perry

In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Perry of the State of North Carolina Johnston County being weak in body but sound in mind do acknowledge this to be my last will and testament I give and bequeath to my son John Perry one cow one hog, one pig and one quart pot. Also I give to Candis Perry daughter of John Perry one bed bedstead and furniture also I give and bequeath to my son William Perry one cow and eight head of hogs also I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Wall one chest. Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Minna Perry two pots and hangers one spider one frying pan one tea kettle one spoon tongs shovel and five irons and looking glass and towel and all my earthenware one tub one pail two piggins one table two spinning wheels four chairs two trays one bread trough one candle stick one box broomman heaters also one honey tub to my daughter Elizabeth Wall also my clothes divided between my ^{grand} two daughters Mary and Elizabeth I give my two grand daughters Elizabeth Wall and Lida Wall one heifer and increase to be equally divided between them one hackle to my son John. I appoint my son John Perry and William Wall executors given under my hand and seal November 22nd day 1814

Will of Isaac Keen

In the name of God Amen I Isaac Keen of Johnston County and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory Sheweth be God do this 23rd day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

First I lend to my well beloved wife Judith Keen one hundred and seventy two acres of land including the plantation whereon I do now live with all the remainder of my property of every kind and description whatever during her natural life or widowhood and at her second marriage or decease my will is that the above mentioned land with all my personal property should be equally divided between my two daughters Niley Keen and Gillish Keen and I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend James Horn and my wife Judith Keen my executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Isaac Keen hath to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
