 Carg one white cow and white heifer and one bed and one
 horse colt to her and her heirs forever.

To my beloved daughter Viney Carg one black cow and
 pided heifer one bed and furniture one chest one mare
 bridle and saddle one axe two plow hoes and one weeding
 hoe all my household and kitchen furniture two sows and
 nine pigs two young sows seven shoats for her next
 years support and one loom and gear and all my crop
 as it now stands corn and fodder crop of cotton to her
 and her heirs forever.

And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend
 William Hinton and Jesse Wall Es. executors of this my last
 will and testament in witness whereof I the said Edward
 Carg have to this my last will and testament set my
 hand and seal the day and year above written.
