

Will of Isaac Bleddor

In the Name of God Amen

I Isaac Bleddor of Johnston County in the Province of North Carolina bring Recit and witness of Body but in perfect sound memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows.

Imprimis - I give and bequeath to my eldest son Isaac Bleddor a parcel of land lying in the County aforesaid bounded from the bottom near the School house down the branch to the mouth, thence across the Creek in a straight course to the back line containing or estimate one hundred acres or the same more or less.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Bleddor the residue of the said tract it being the land where I now live for and during her natural life and after her decease to descend to my youngest son Benjamin his heirs or assigns forever. As for my movable effects than is mentioned hereof I give to her the said Mary Bleddor so long as she shall remain a widow, true is she should many moreables to be sold and she to have  $\frac{1}{3}$  part of the effects to be equally divided amongst my daughters Mary, Eliza and Nellie. I give and bequeath to my son John Bleddor a parcel and tract of land lying between the tract aforesaid mentioned and up Robert's Creek to him and his heirs forever also Black Horse and a cow as he maye make choice of before

I also give to my eldest son Isaac Bleddor to be mentioned above three cows and pigs

I also give to my youngest son Benjamin a mare and colt under the name of Bond Bull and I also appoint my loving wife one executrix and my eldest son Isaac Bleddor the other Executrix of this my last will and testament. Reserving disannulling and utterly making void all former wills gifts legacies grants I before me made acknowledging this only to be my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this the twenty ninth day of December One thousand seven hundred and sixty.

Will of Arch MacLory

In the Name of God Amen

Johnston County in the Province of North Carolina I Arch MacLory do ordain and make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to say first and principally I give and bequeath my soul to the hands of Almighty God that gave it to me nothing doubting but that I shall receive the same again from the hands of my creator we somone at the day of the general ressurection and my body to the earth from which it came to be buried after a Christian decent manner at the discretion of my executors whom I shall hereafter appoint and as for what worldly goods it hath beene given to me to follow on me after my just debts and funeral expenses are paid I give and bequeath as follows

Imprimis - I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Catherine MacLory three Negro named Bob, Jane and Peas and one stallion called Bull and the plantation whereon I now live

I give and bequeath to my beloved grandson Micajah MacLory the plantation and tract of land on Crabtree creek whereon James Childress formerly dwelt and one negro boy named Bob to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my beloved son named Anderson MacLory my mill and all the lands adjoining to it so long as Bleddor Branch and one negro boy named Buck to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my beloved son John MacLory the plantation and tract of land I now live on and after the decease of my wife Catherine one negro boy named Porter to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my beloved son Andrew MacLory one hundred acres of land taken out of the tract I now live on lying on Marsh Creek and not coming nearer the plantation than the red soil and one negro boy named Will to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Catherine one hundred acres of land part of the tract I now live on and a place called the Indian spoke with the land opposite thereto and on the south side of the Creek to said corner end of the line and one negro girl named Nell and one young yearling creature to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Francis the upper end of the Marsh Creek land called the Stog farm and a negro boy named Dick to her and her heirs forever

My will and desire is that if it should please god any of my children above mentioned or my grand child Micajah should die before they come to age, the boys twenty one and the girls sixteen years or married or having half issue that then his or her part to be equally divided among the survivors

My will and desire is that all the remainder of my estate both real and personal may be equally divided between my wife and children at the discretion of my Executor for my desire that my estate
