Item I give unto his daughter Miss Mary Houlden my two negroes Wille and Charles and further by these acknowledgements I will that Col William Hinton be and I do appoint him my executor in full force and value and know all men by these present & do hereby revoke and exclude all former wills by me made in any wise.

Will of Isaac Jones Sr.

In the name of God Amen Isaac Jones Sr. of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound disposing mind and memory thanks be to God, do make and ordain this and only this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit:

First I give and bequeath unto my daughter Barbara Copeland wife of Charles Copeland three negro women by the name of Hannah, Abby and Sally also two cows and calves two ewes and lambs and two pigs and pigs also eighty acres of land not cleared on the south side of White Oak adjoining the lands of Theophilus Pool and Cedar Acre to her and her heirs forever some

Item I give and bequeath unto my granddaughter Ally Price wife of James Price fifty acres of land lying on the North side of White Oak adjoining the lands of Reason Johnson and Phillip Johnson one woman saddle to her and her heirs forever, also I give to Ally Price one cow and one iron pot to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto Isaac Jones my grandson one feather bed and furniture also one bay horse to him and his heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Reuben Sanders executor to this my last will and testament revoking and declaring all other former wills by me made void.
