

Will of James Watson

In the name of God Amen I James Watson of Johnston County and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God so this 23rd day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say,

I lend to my beloved wife two hundred and fifty acres of land including the houses and plantation wherein I now live, that is two hundred acres of my old tract of land and fifty acres taken off of the land I bought of Isaac Ken joining the same during her natural life or widowhood, and at her decease I give the above mentioned land to my son Allen Watson.

I also lend to said wife one mare and all my stock of cattle hogs and sheep and all my household and kitchen furniture and all my plantation tools of every kind during her life aforesaid Then my will is that the above mentioned personal property should be equally divided between my four youngest children that is to say, Tobias, Zephaniah, Allen and Spicay.

I give to my son Tobias one hundred and fifty acres of land joining of the land I have left to my wife and Jesse Sullivan and provided he comes back from the Alabama where I understand he now resides if otherwise I desire said land should be equally divided between my sons Hazzie and Allen.

I also give to said Tobias one horse colt provided he comes back as aforesaid if not any will is that my son Allen should have the colt.

I give to my son Hazzie one hundred acres of land joining of Jesse Sullivan's lands and the lands which I have given to my son Tobias.

I give to my son Hazzie one stud horse.

The mare I have lent my wife being with foal I give the colt to my son Allen if it comes to good And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friends Henry Lasser and my son Hazzie Watson executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said James Watson have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
