

Will of Jasper Jernigan

In the name of God Amen. I Jasper Jernigan of Johnston County in the State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory blessed be God do this 14th day of April in the year our lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) after my just debts are paid by my Executors

First I give and bequeath to my son Marlon Jernigan my whole estate both real and personal to be by him possessed and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever and if he or they shall die before he shall come of age to make a Will then and in that case I do give my estate in the following manner (to wit) To my sister-in-law Sarah Yates daughter of Daniel Yates of Caswell County one negro girl called Peggy and her increase and to my niece Zephania Jernigan one negro girl called China and one negro girl called Pinner and their increase forever and to my nephew Henry Strains the remainder part of my estate both real & personal after the death of my mother who I desire may not be molested from my estate during her life to him or his heirs forever

Item My will and desire is that my estate that is the perishable part thereof and so much be sold by Executors and not by the Sheriff of these months August and the money arising from the sale thereof be put to me for the benefit and support and for the sole interest of schooling my son and the land to be run out and slaves hired from year to year and the money arising therefrom to be put to me for the benefit of raising my said son.

Item My will and desire is that my son may have a good Education as can be had in this Settlement or wherever my Executors may think necessary to send him in this State as long as they may think necessary

Item I do hereby make and ordain my father-in-law Daniel Yates my nephew Henry Strains and my friend Jesse Piner Executors of this my last Will and Testament
