

## Will of John Ogburn

In the name of God Amen I John Ogburn of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being weak and has in health of body but of sound mind and perfect sense and memory do make this my last will and testament in manner following (to wit;

I wish all my just debts to be paid

I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Ogburn one negro woman named Neey and one negro boy named George in full

I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Ogburn three feather beds household and kitchen furniture she may have named Pigeon two cows and calves all my corn and fodder and working tools except one hand saw and all my stock of hogs and pork all my cider casks during her lifetime or widowhood

I give to my well beloved daughter Sarah Ogburn one negro girl named Mariah one feather bed and furniture one cow & calf.

I give to my well beloved daughter Lucy Young one negro girl named Evelinah.

I give to my beloved daughter Charlotte Williams one negro girl named Leah.

I give to my son Stephenson Ogburn one negro boy named Julius

I give to my son Calvin Ogburn one negro boy named, one grind stone and one hand saw.

All the property that I give to my wife Mary Ogburn except the negro woman Neey & George to be equally divided among all my children at their death or widowhood

I leave one mare grained Jewel and the ballance of my stock of cattle to be sold and equally divided between all my children declaring this and this only to be my last will in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> of December 1841. ## Will of Joel West Jr

In the name of God Amen I Joel West Jr of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina do the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six do blessed be God make publick and declare this to be my last will and testament knowing that God has ordained for all men to die

I recommend my soul to God who first gave it and my body to be buried with a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors hereafter to be appointed

It is my will that all my just debts be first paid I give and bequeath to my beloved wife West two feather beds her choice from among all of my beds except my daughter Spicy West's bed.

I will to be sold by my executors one hundred & thirty six acres of land known by name of the old brickolds Land also sixty four acres right through the center of the land which I have deeded away heretofore also eighty four acres the land wherein Gary Johnson now lies the above mentioned land to be sold on a credit of six months also it is my will that all of my stock of horses, hogs cattle sheep Household and kitchen furniture, farming utensils and every part and particle of property which I have not deeded or transferred in writing to be sold by my executors on a credit of six months.

I leave in the hands of my son Loyd West three hundred acres of land which I have deeded to three of my grand children to take care of the same and pay the taxes of said land until they become twenty one years of age.

It is my will that the monies arising from the sale of my property be applied to use of paying just debts and after paying all of debts the residue if any be equally divided between my son Joel West and my daughters Sarah Nancy Mary and Spicy and I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Joel West and my son Loyd West executors to this my last will and testament signed sealed in the presence of those who are present at the) Joel West (Seal)
