

Will of John Whitley Jr.

In the name of God Amen I John Whitley Jr. of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being of sound and full mind and memory do this 15th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen make constitute and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say after residing to myself during my natural life the benefit privilege and of all my property as usual I give and bequeath in manner following.

First My will and desire is that all my lawful debts be discharged by my executors hereafter mentioned.

Item I bequeath to my beloved wife Esther Whitley during her widowhood or natural life the use of the upper part of my plantation where I now live including part of the buildings as well be hereafter mentioned a division line to begin at the sun of the Wolf Pitt branch where the path that leads from my mill to my present dwelling house across said branch thence running e^{ast}! Mill path as it now stands through two large gates and continuing said as the pathway go down s^{outh} a path to the Beaver Dam and crossing the sun of said Beaver Dam and along the upper path that leads from said Beaver Dam to the Yar Landing on the river Neuse and to a corner called the three red oak sprouts corner thence up the various corners of the river to my upper corner on said river also Jessie Timers former corner thence along said Timers lower lines and my upper lines as they now stand out to the aforesaid Wolf Pitt branch thence down the various courses of said Wolf Pitt branch to the beginning at the aforesaid Mill path also the use and privilege of two rooms belonging to my now dwelling house that is to say the lower and upper rooms in the south end of said house known by the name of the Chamber rooms together with the use and benefit of any kitchen house containing \$ 50 acres more or less.

Item I bequeath to my beloved wife Esther Whitley during her natural life or widowhood one negro man slave called Peter one negro man slave named Jacob, one negro girl slave named Lucy, one negro girl slave named Abby, one negro girl slave named Violet, one negro boy slave named Harry, one negro boy slave named Abram, one horse called Dobbin one mare called Tim one year old colt called Peacock four cows and calves four ewes and lambs four son and pigs fifteen head of year old hogs twenty geese ten head of poultry two feather beds and furniture bedsteads hides and cords

six windsor chairs one large table one small table one pair fine dogs one pot bramnel one pair fire tongs and shovel one pair flat irons and one half of my plantation tools of every kind, two iron pots known by the name of the Bricks and middle size big pot one frying pan known by the name of the big pan one skillet known by name of the big skillet one large pewter dish one pewter dish known by the name of the middle size deep dish six pewter plates six pewter spoons one case of knives and forks one wine wheel one wooden wheel one trunk one chest one double riding chase and gear or harness. One woman's saddle and bridle, one bell metal spice mortar and pestle one bofar half dozen tea cups and saucers six earthen plates sixteen spoons one coffee mill one loom and weaving gear two earthen quart bowls one pitcher known by the name of the Barna pitcher six common sitting chairs.

My will and desire is that the residue of my stock of cattle kind and description after raising seventy dollars out of said stock of horses cattle hogs &c to my bro Neetham Whitley and three sons (viz) Cedar, William and Jessie Whitley as herein after specified and not given or otherwise disposed of shall descend to my beloved John Whitley Jr to him and his heirs and assigns forever also the residue of my household and kitchen furniture not disposed of in any manner (if any) shall descend to my said son John Whitley Jr in manner as aforesaid to him and his heirs assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my brother Neetham Whitley to him his heirs and assigns forever twenty five dollars current money. I give and bequeath to my nephew Cedar Whitley to him his heirs assigns forever twenty dollars current money.

I give and bequeath to my nephew William Whitley to him his heirs assigns forever fifteen dollars current money.

I give and bequeath to my nephew Jessie Whitley to him his heirs assigns forever ten dollars current money which four parts bequeaths to be raised by my executors out of my stock of horses and cattle &c

I give and bequeath to Sarah Atkinson widow of Elias Atkinson fifteen dollars current money to be raised of and from my stock as aforesaid for the purpose of building her a dwelling house fourteen by eighteen feet with a chimney &

Build of dogs

My will and devise is further that a negro woman named Phillis and one negro woman named Miley be free and discharged from any bondage or servitude towards any of my family but to be constituted as entirely free and as in my power to do and the said negro women (viz) Phillis and Miley to be under the care and protection of my beloved wife Esther Whitley during her natural life after which time to be under the care of my son John Whitley Jr his heirs & neither to be subject to any sale or division whatever also my devise further is that a negro girl Chana go with said Phillis during her life to look after and work for the maintenance of the said Phillis after which time the said negro girl Chana and her increase to revert wholly to the use and benefit of my son John Whitley Jr his heirs and assigns forever also that a negro girl named Rhoda go with said negro woman Miley during the natural life of my wife Esther Whitley to look after and work for the maintenance of the said Miley and after the death of my said wife before said then to be under the care and protection of my said son John Whitley Jr his heirs assigns during the natural life of said negro woman Miley in like manner as aforesaid then the said negro girl Rhoda and her increase to revert wholly to use and benefit &c of my son John Whitley Jr his heirs assigns forever.

Item

My will and devise further is that after the death or widowhood of my beloved wife Esther Whitley that all the negroes which I now her namely negro man Primus, Jacob negro girl Abby, Treasy & Violet, negro boys Hardy and Abram if living to gather with all increase of said negroes shall be and descend to my son John Whitley Jr as his sole right and property to him his heirs and assigns forever. Also that all the plantation tools of every kind and description and all the stock of every kind till any should remain and all the household and kitchen furniture together with every other article of like kind or nature shall descend to and become the sole right and property of my son John Whitley Jr his heirs assigns forever.

And I hereby make and constitute my beloved wife Esther Whitley my truly friends Joseph Ingram Sr and John Williams Executors of this my last will and

t testament in witness whereof I the said John Whitley Sr have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above or written written Signed sealed published and declared by the said John Whitley Sr the testator as his last will and testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing and
