

John Whiff's "Will"

In the name of God Amen - I John Whiff of Johnston County and provision  
of North Carolina being sick and weak but of sound and disposing memory  
thank to to God for it calling to mind the great mortality of mankind and  
my affairs I do obtain this my last will and testament in manner and form  
following

- Item First I give my soul to god who gave it to me and next my body to the ground  
to be buried in a decent order at the discretion of my executors
- Item I give to Joseph Boon One Hundred acres of land lying in the islands and  
my son John Two hundred acres adjoining the above land and to my son  
Neshawn Two Hundred acres adjoining the same the whole containing six  
hundred acres.
- Item I give to my son John the manor plantation wheron I live and three  
hundred and fifty acres adjoining the same and three negroes named  
Primus and Phillis
- Item I give to my son Neshawn a tract of land on Spain Creek against  
Salem first containing One hundred acres and three negroes Ned, Lucy  
and Jerry
- Item I give to my daughter Jemima one Negro named Parson and Twenty five  
pounds for the care of the said Negro and in case he dies I give her three  
pounds five shillings in stead of the Negro and a horse worth three pounds for  
proclamation in stead of the Negro and a horse worth three pounds pro-  
clamation and Two Cows and Calves, two Ews and Lambs and one Gander bed and  
furniture and a piece of Chenice a pattern for a gown
- Item I give to my daughter Jemima Two Cows and Calves two Ews and Lambs  
and a horse worth three pounds proclamation one Gander bed and  
furniture and Twenty pounds proclamation
- Item I give my daughter Elizabth Twenty pounds proclamation money Two Cows  
and Calves two Ews and Lambs, One horse worth three pounds proclamation  
and one Gander bed and furniture
- Item I give to my daughter Nancy Twenty pounds proclamation money Two Cows  
and Calves two Ews and Lambs and one horse worth three  
pounds proclamation one Gander bed and furniture
- Item I give to my daughter Caesar Twenty pounds proclamation Two Cows  
and Calves, Two Ews and Lambs One Gander bed and furniture and one  
horse worth Three pounds proclamation
- Item I give to my Grand Child Necess Ballard five pounds proclamation  
money
- Item I give to my Two sons every year schooling apiece and one apiece  
to my four daughters
- Item If the two masters should bring negro children enough for  
my daughters to have them in the room of Twenty pounds one  
apiece

I give the rest of my estate to be equally divided between my two Sons  
John and Neshawn

Lastly I appoint Ben Williams and Joseph Boon whole and sole exec-  
utors of this my last will and testament revoking all the other wills  
or Wills here before by me made.

At an ordinary Court of pleas and quarter session begun  
and held for the said County at the Court house at Marion quartered  
on the third Tuesday in October Anno Domini 1761

Present his Maj: Justices - That the within and above last Will and  
Testament of John Whiff late of Johnston County Dead Executed into  
Court and proved by the oath of Thos Whiff and Henry Bull subscribing  
witnesses thereto who swear that they saw said Testator sign seal publish  
and declare the same to be his last Will and testamant that he was  
of sound and perfect mind and memory and at the same time they  
saw Nathan Gurley subscribe the same with them also the said  
Ben Williams, Joseph Boon appear in Court and Qualified themselves  
as Executors agreeable to Law Ordered that the secretary have  
notice hereof that Letters Testamentary issue accordingly
