Will of Kiddy Omeal

In the name of God Amen I Kiddy Omeal of the State of North Carolina Johnston County being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God do this 5<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

First I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Belle Atkison one mare and colt two cows and calves one feather bed and furniture that I generally lie on myself and all my sheep one sow and pigs and four year old hogs and one quilt part of the hogs that is now up of fattening.

Secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Penelope Green the sum of forty shillings and equal part of the fat hogs

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved grand daughter Betsey Harriet Green one hunting saddle one cow and calf

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my beloved grandson William Green one cow and calf and one sow and some shoats

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my beloved grandson John C. Green one cow and yearling.

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my beloved son Allen S. Omeal one yoke of oxen and cart and wheels three head of cattle one feather bed and furniture one sow with pig and one quilt part of the fat hogs the residue of my property to be sold to pay my debts the ballance to be equally divided between Allen S. Omeal and Belle Atkison and John C. Green & I hereby make and ordain my beloved son and son in law Allen S. Omeal and Cary Atkison my executors of this my last will and testament in witness hereof I the said Kiddy Omeal have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed published and declared by the said Kiddy Omeal the testator as her last will and testament in the presence of us witnesses
