Will of Leroy Brannon

In the name of God Amen I Leroy Brannon of Johnston County
 and State of North Carolina being in my perfect senses and
 memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty
 of life and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make this my last will and testament first recommending
 my soul to God who gave it and my body to the ground from
 whence it was taken to be buried in a decent manner after
 the burial of a christian at the discretion of my friends
 then I bestow my estate in the following manner viz:

First I lend unto my beloved wife Rebekah Brannon the land
 and plantation whereon I now dwell during her natural life
 or widowhood and at her death or marriage then I give and
 bequeath unto my beloved sons Thomas Brannon, John Brannon
 James Brannon Leroy Brannon and Solomon Brannon the
 same lands to be equally divided between my five sons above
 named. Secondly I give and bequeath unto my two beloved
 daughters Elizabeth Brannon Cetrach Brannon one feather bed
 and furniture to each. Lastly I leave all the balance of my
 estate to be sold and all the money arising therefrom collected
 and my just debts be paid and if any money left to be equally
 divided between my beloved wife Rebekah Brannon and my seven
 children Thomas Brannon John Brannon James Brannon Leroy
 Brannon and Solomon Brannon, Elizabeth Brannon and Cetrach
 Brannon and I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
 friends Nealichia Hinton and William Hinton as executors to
 my last will. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this 10th day of March in the year
 of our Lord A. D. 1808.
