one tea kettle my largest iron pot one iron kettle my largest table
and my best table cloth half my cotton and flax my Room slays
barrels and gears there unto belonging my butter pot two candle stand
and one pair of candle snuffers one flax wheel my best cotton wheel
my best cloak my weaving clothes three bee hives all my spun cotton
and wool one pair cotton cards all my knives and forks one small purple
bottle three pewter basins four pewter plates one pewter dish and
and six spoons all my tubs pails piggins and trays one Japan service
one pair of fire tongs and one tea funnel.
