Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved son William Peppar Oliver after the death of Dinah Oliver his mother all my lands lying on the north side of Neuse river and all the rest of my property to be equally divided between my two daughters Patsey and Polly Oliver and my son William Peppar Oliver after the death of Dinah Oliver their mother.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my friend Samuel G. Smith executors to this my last will and testament hereby revoking disannulling and making void all former wills by me made in witness whereof I the 1st Henry Oliver have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 26th November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen signed sealed and declared by the testator in his life time to be his last will and testament in presence of

Will of Joel Renfrow

In the name of God Amen I Joel Renfrow of the State of North Carolina and County of Johnston being of sound and perfect mind memory blessed be God do this 14th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

First I lend to my beloved wife Charity Renfrow the land and the plantation whereon I now live including the plantation also my feather bed and furniture 8 head of cattle 4 head of sheep one sorrel horse all my household and kitchen furniture except my feather beds during her natural life or widow-hood then 150 acres of land to my beloved son Joel Renfrow adjoining Stephen Grice lands and James Adams and the residue of the legacy to belong to my beloved son Willie Renfrow.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah Sanders the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Patience Barnes the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Renfrow the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Stephen Renfrow the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Penelope Barnes the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Josiah Renfrow one bed, and furniture two head of sheep also the sum of twenty shillings

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son James Renfrow the sum of ten shillings

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Edith Fennell the sum of ten shilling.

Item I give and bequeath unto any beloved son Joel Renfrow the land

and bridle and saddle that is now called his own bed and furniture & head of sheep also the sum of twenty shillings

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Charity Renfrow one bed and furniture & head of sheep also the sum of twenty shillings.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Zilphia Renfrow all working utensil of all kinds.

I lend to my beloved wife Charity Renfrow during her natural life or widowhood and thence to my son Willie as before also all the hogs that shall be found in my mark lend to my wife Char and Willie as before also of head of sheep I lend to my beloved wife Charity and Willie as before.

I lend all my property not before mentioned in legacies to be sold and the money arising therefrom be appropriated to the payment of debts and several legacies and if my remainder to be appropriated to the use of Noel, Josiah, Charity, Zilphia and Willie Renfrow. I hereby make and ordain my beloved son William Renfrow and Stanley Clement executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof the said Noel Renfrow have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

Will of William Holloman

In the name of God Amen I William Holloman of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being of sound and disposing mind and memory thanks be to God for the same do this 16th day November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following,

First I give and bequeath to my son Jesse Holloman all my lands and tenements including the plantation wherein I now live with the several tracts adjoining or elsewhere also my negro man name Eddie one copper kettle one small iron pot and hooks one painted dining table one pewter dish and all my pewter plates one pewter bacon all my cedar casks and all my working tools of every kind) demolition and all my chairs to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

Second I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Dennis Bailey fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever.

Thirdly My will and desire that all my stock of cattle, hogs horses sheep
cows, fodder, brandy, cider household furniture of every kind not herein
to given be sold but public sale by my executors or some one else duly
authorized and the money arising from such sale with all my money
that I shall have at my death and such as shall be owing to
me after being collected and all my just debts punctually paid
to be equally divided between my two sons and daughters (to wit)
Josiah Holloman, Tobias Holloman and Elizabeth Bailey share and
alike to them and their heirs forever.

Fourthly and lastly I hereby appoint make and ordain any friend Joseph Richardson executor to this my last will and testament and
revoking and making null and void all others by me made ratifying
and confirming this my last will and testament in witness whereof
I the said William Holloman have hereunto set my hand and
