Will signed 10 March 1789: Probated May Term, 1789

In the name of God Amen, the tenth day of March 1789 I Edward PRICE of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God, for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed that all men must die have there fore made this my last will and testament that is to say considering my worldly estate where with God has blessed me with, I give devise and dispose of it in the following manner and form.

I give and bequeath to my grandson Samuel PRICE son of my daughter Winnie PRICE one hundred acres of land to be taken out of the lower end of my land I live on.

I give and bequeath to my beloved son Simon PRICE my house orchard plantation and all the residue of my land and (anisuages?) except that part before willed to Samuel PRICE.
