

Will of Phereby Sauls

In the name of God Amen, We Thosby Souls of Johnston Co
and State of North Carolina, being now and weak in body but
of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God do
this ninth of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirteen do make and publish this my will
and testament in manner following (to wit) after all my
just debts and funeral expenses is paid I dispose of what property
it hath pleased God to bestow on me in manner following

First- I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Phoebe Sauls daughter of Rezin Sauls one negro girl named Aggy to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Phoebe Penny daughter of Alexander Penny ten pounds to her and her heirs and assigns forever to be paid her by my executor herein after named - and to further any desire after my death who ever keeps my said granddaughter Phoebe Sauls shall have the benefit of said negro Peggy for the support of my said grand daughter

And it is further my desire that after my death my negro boy Jerry should be hired out for the term of five years and if William Johnson should come before the five years should expire that the said Jerry is to be sold and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided amongst my children that is, living (to wit) Esther Smith wife of Richard H. Smith, Sell Johnson, William Johnson, Phillip Johnson, Rodin Sauls, Dan Sauls, Belle Pool wife of Nathaniel Pool.

And it is further my desire that after my death all the remainder part of my property consisting of negroes, house hold and kitchen furniture, my stock of horses cattle and hogs shall be sold by my executor herein after named and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided amongst my children that is now living, and I do hereby constitute and appoint my son David Sauls executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Phoebe Sauls have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
