

Will of Winifred Perry

In the name of God Amen, I Winifred Perry of Johnston Co.
being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God
do this 9th day of October in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty make and publish this
my last will and testament in manner following that is to

First - Give and bequeath unto sister Mollie Wall my saddle and
bridle for her life time, and then to be the property of her
daughter Phency our chert to the said Phency Wall. The
out property from my decease, one half doz of pewter plates
to Jesse Wall's daughter Elizabeth one pot and a set of tea
ware to the said Elizabeth Wall daughter of Jesse Wall Sr
one half doz pewter plates one bacon and half dozen spoons
to Elizabeth Wall daughter of William Wall.
Ten dollars in money to the said Elizabeth Wall daughter of
said William Wall the pot one tea kettle and one looking
glass to the said Elizabeth Wall daughter of said William
Wall one bed and furniture one counterpane one bed quilt
and two pillow cases excepted, one trunk to Polly Perry
daughter of John Perry one wooden wheel one double wooden
counterpane two pillow cases and one towell and one bed
quilt to the above named Elizabeth Wall daughter of said
Wall Sr the balance of my household furniture to be equally
divided between sister Mollie and sister Betsy.
I want brother Jesse Wall Sr to have five dollars extra for
his trouble he has had to undergo in my sickness and all
the rest of my property to be equally divided between his
John Perry his wife William Perry and sister Mollie Wall and sister
Betsy Wall. All the property that I have left to sister
Mollie Wall I want to be equally divided between her three
heirs at her decease. Three suits of homespun clothes to
John Perry wife two suits of fine clothes to Elizabeth Wall
daughter of Jesse Wall Sr, one cloak one pair of stockings and
one homespun suit of clothes to sister Mollie Wall the third
part of the balance of my clothes to be equally divided
between Polly Perry and Elizabeth Wall daughter of William
Wall the balance of my clothes to be equally divided between
sister Mollie and her daughters, sister Betsy and her daughters his
John Perry's daughters and brother William Perry's daughters and
I hereby make and ordain any worthy friend Jesse Wall Sr
executor of this my last will and testament. In witness
