Will of William Hoinnant

In the name of God Amen, I William Hoinnant Sr of the state of North Carolina and Johnston County being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God for the same do this 16th day of June in the year of our Lord 1801 make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to be buried at the discretion of my executors.

- Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son James Hoinnant five shillings to be raised out of my estate.
- Item I give to my daughter Charity Kempson five shillings as also I give to my son John Hoinnant five shillings as also I give to my son William Hoinnant five shillings.
- Item I give to my beloved son Gosciah Hoinnant one negro man named Sezer to be delivered to him after the death of myself and his mother also one feather bed and furniture also two cows and one yearling also two ewes and lambs one iron pot one shot gun one pewter dish and three pewter plates and six spoons and all the rest of my estate be it of what soever kind or nature it may be besides what is above mentioned.
- Item I lend to my beloved wife Mary Hoinnant during her natural life a widowhood, and then to be equally divided between my five youngest daughters and my grandson Jesse Goyer to wit Jean Adams, Nellie Gannett, Bethana Hoinnant, Edith Gwinn and Sarah Kempson to be equally divided between them at the discretion of my executors and I do hereby make and ordain my beloved sons William and Gosciah Hoinnant my executors of this my last will and testament in witness my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed published and declared by the said William Hoinnant to be his last will and testament in presence of us.
