I lend to my beloved wife Charity Renfrow during her natural life or widowhood and thence to my son Willie as before also all the hogs that shall be found in my mark land to my wife Char and Willie as before also of head of sheep I lend to my beloved wife Charity and Willie as before.

I lend all my property not before mentioned in legacies to be sold and the money arising therefrom be appropriated to the payment of debts and several legacies and if my remainder to be appropriated to the use of Noel, Josiah, Charity, Zilphia and Willie Renfrow. I hereby make and ordain my beloved son William Renfrow and Stanley Clement executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof the said Noel Renfrow have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

Will of William Holloman

In the name of God Amen I William Holloman of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina being of sound and disposing mind and memory thanks be to God for the same do this 16th day November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following,

First I give and bequeath to my son Jesse Holloman all my lands and tenements including the plantation wherein I now live with the several tracts adjoining or elsewhere also my negro man name Eddie one copper kettle one small iron pot and hooks one painted dining table one pewter dish and all my pewter plates one pewter bacon all my cedar casks and all my working tools of every kind) demolition and all my chairs to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

Second I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Dennis Bailey fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever.

Thirdly My will and desire that all my stock of cattle, hogs horses sheep
cows, fodder, brandy, cider household furniture of every kind not herein
to given be sold but public sale by my executors or some one else duly
authorized and the money arising from such sale with all my money
that I shall have at my death and such as shall be owing to
me after being collected and all my just debts punctually paid
to be equally divided between my two sons and daughters (to wit)
Josiah Holloman, Tobias Holloman and Elizabeth Bailey share and
alike to them and their heirs forever.

Fourthly and lastly I hereby appoint make and ordain any friend Joseph Richardson executor to this my last will and testament and
revoking and making null and void all others by me made ratifying
and confirming this my last will and testament in witness whereof
