County of Johnston in the State of North Carolina, being weak
in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed
be God and calling to mind the mortality of the body that
it is appointed for all men once to die do this the 25th of
February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight-
hundred and ten make publick satisfy establish and ordain
this and no other to be my last will and testament - first of
all I recommend my soul to God who gave it - nothing doubting
but I shall receive it again in the morning of the general
resurrection where soul and body will unite and my body to
the dust to be buried in a Christian like manner at the
discretion of my executors hereafter named as touching my
worldly estate that it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me
with in this life I dispose of in manner and form following
viz; first - my will is that all my just debts and funeral
charges be satisfied and paid

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved aunt Susanah Langston
all my stock of cattle to her and her heirs and assigns forever
