

Will of Zacharias Oweale

In the name of God Amen. The 20th day of March 18th,
I Zacharias Oweale of Johnston County in the State of
North Carolina, being very sick and weak in body but of
perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God for
the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body
and knowing that I have once to die do make and ordain
this my last will and testament as touching my worldly
estate wherewith hath pleased God to bless me with in
this life, I give and devise in the following manner as
follows.

I give and bequeath to my loving son Thomas Oweale
four hundred acres of land in this County being the land
I purchased of Need Gullett and took a title in my son
said Thomas Oweale name for the same I give to him his
heirs and assigns forever, he first paying and taking up
obligation of one hundred dollars given Need Gullett for
last payment of said land also I give to my said son
Thomas one mare of a sorrel color and one shot gun also
the household furniture that I have given him heretofore
in his possession.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving friend John Ogden
one sorrel mare with a saddle and bridle.

Item I give to my loving wife three work horses two saddles
and bridles also six cows and their calves four head
sheep also one feather bed, and furniture during her life time.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Winnie
two cows and calves two head of sheep also one feather
bed and furniture also six head of hogs freely to be by
her possessed.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Cassy
Oweale two cows and yearling and one feather bed, and fu-
rniture six head of hogs two sheep freely to her to be
possessed.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Edie Oweale
two cows and yearlings one feather bed and furniture

six head of hogs two sheep freely to be by her to be possessed,

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Lodwick Oweale my lower
lands and plantations on Little River in this County being the land
and plantation I purchased of Steven Young to him and his heirs
assigns forever also two cows and yearlings freely by him to be possessed.

Item I give to my aforesaid Ann all the remainder of my stock of
hogs besides that is not heretofore willed also I give her all
my corn and melle now laid up for her use to support my family
or so long as the same will serve her also I give to my said
wife Ann my negro named Dick during the time of her life
time or being my widow and after her death or marriage I give the
said negro man Dick to my loving son Steven Oweale to him and his
heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give to my beloved wife Ann the use and servis of my negro
man Peter and negro woman Ginny during the time of her
natural life and after my said wifes death.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Horicajah Oweale my aforesaid
negro man Peter to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Lodwick Oweale after death of said
wife my said negro woman named Ginny to him and his heirs and assigns
forever.

Item I give to my said wife Ann the use and privilege of my land and plantation
wherem we now live during her natural life time and after the death of my
said wife. I give and bequeath the said land and plantation wherem we
now live to my loving son Horicajah Oweale to him and his heirs and assigns
forever. I also give to my said son Horicajah Oweale two cows and yearling
freely to be by him possessed.

Item I give to my loving wife Ann all the remainder part of my cattle not
before willed also I give to my said wife all my dwelling house and
kitchen furniture that I have not before willed to her during her ^{natural} life
and after her death to be all except one feather bed and furniture to
be equally to be divided between my daughters hereof named, that is to
say Abby Hoccut, Winnie Oweale, Cassy Oweale and Edie Oweale freely to be
by them possessed.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Steven Oweale after the death
of my wife one feather bed and furniture.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Thomas Oweale one cart

and wheels freely to be by him possessed.

I give to my loving wife one cart and wheels I also give to my said wife all my working tools of every nature with all the residue of my estate to I also constitute and appoint my loving wife Ann Creale and my loving son Thomas Creale executors of this my last will and testament revoking and disannulling all other and former will or wills executors and executrix satisfying and conforming this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed and pronounced to be the last will and testament of Zacharias Creale in the presence of us

Execution of this will receive any part as aforesaid and do constitute and appoint Samuel Smith and Ann Pool executors of this my last will and testament in witness hereof have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of October 17
