I give to my two Daughters Mary & Elizabeth Cox one Shilling each lawful money one and above what they have already

I give to my son Reuben Godson one Cow half, I give to my son James Godson all my Turners tools I leave the use and benefit of all the rest of my estate of what nature or kind soever and wherever the same may be found to my Loving Wife Rebekah Godson during her natural life Except one Feather Bed and furniture which I give to her the said Rebekah Godson forever and at the Death of my Wife Rebekah I give the Estate that is above mentioned in the will (sent to my wife) in manner following one best Bed and furniture to my son Frederick Godson, then the one half part of the remainder of said property I also give to my said Frederick the other half part I give to my Son Daniel Burdick, Moses & James Godson to be equally divided between them or their issue

I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Cox one large Peter Dish at her death I And lastly I nominate and appoint my son Moses Frederick Godson Executor to this my last will and testament Unknown Ladings and Confirming this to be the only to be my last will & Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th Sept 1787

In the Name of God Amen I Mitchell Burck of Jones County and state of North Carolina Planter being sick in body but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows viz I give and leave unto my beloved Wife Mary Burck all my Land and Plantations during her natural life or widowhood and if she carries to have one third to her or her issue During her natural life I also give and bequeath unto my beloved Wifely Mary Burck and said I bequeath unto her Feather Bed and furniture one Chest one Table one Wooden Bed one Chamber one Bed one Pillow one Scillet one Spoon five Chairs one Peter Dish one Dish one Plate one Tray one Box of Knives and forks one Tub one Pail one Pan also Twenty barrels of Corn and all my Mite that I have Now or

Bar How one flock one hoe one or one pair of Iron  
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Enelope Burck one Feather Bed and furniture also one Dish to be delivered then the Corn of age  
I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Samuel Andrew Burck all my Land and Plantations to him his heirs and assigns forever  
All the Rests of my Estate to be sold at the Discretion of my Executors and all my just Debts Paid and the Remainder to be Equally Divided between my Daughter Enelope and my son Samuel Burck  
I hereby nominate and constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Mary Burck and Abigail Perry my Executors to this my last will and Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day and year first above written

woman named Diner one Negro Boy named Will and one Negro boy  
named Tom to her her heirs and assigns for ever  
I give and bequeath to my son Lot Fragar W. John Haywoods Bonds  
make him a Right to a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying near  
Mundines Mill in Onslow County the boundaries of which is contained  
in the Deed of two Negroes named Toney & Caesar to be sold  
taken on yoke of young Oxen one plow & Chain one saw and pig  
Iron two year old barrow one Bed & Furniture one Iron pot three
