I, Abraham D. Simmons of Hance County by State of S. Carolina &
Son of Jonathan being weak in body but of sound mind & memory
thank God for it do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in
manner and form following
Item, I give to my son Isaac Simmon all the lands I hold on
the South side of Crooked Run joining his own line to Hatch's as far
as the long Branch commonly called Antunes Branch to him
for his & his heirs & assigns for ever
Item, I give to my daughter Polly Simmon the house & lot of ground
in Trenton known in the plan of said Town by N. 1. 99 twenty nine
acres & one hundred & four rods, same name as her Mother named
Hannah, one cow & Calf, one feather Bed &
furniture to her, her Agnes & signs for ever
Item, I give to my son in law Richard Morris one hundred & four acres
of land on the North side of Trent River on the head of Morris' branch
to him & his heirs & assigns for ever
Item, I give to my daughter Elizabeth Simmon one hundred
acres of land on the North side of Trent River known by the Name
of Morris one Negro boy named Miller, one cow & Calf, one
feather Bed & furniture to her, her Agnes & signs for ever
Item, I give to my Daughter Anna Simmon the land wherein
Richard Morris now lives on the South side of Trent River joining Morris' branch
to her, her Agnes & signs for ever
Item, I give to my Son Thomas Simmon the house & lots wherein I now
live on the East side of Cherry Street together with all the lands I hold above
Cherry Street on both sides of the River which I purchased of John
Richards father except that lot given to Polly Simmon. I also give
to my son Thomas Simmon one Negro man name'd Luke, one
cow & Calf, one feather Bed & furniture, two ploughs, two Axes, two Hoes,
six Chairs, one Table & what bedding is in the House, also my little gun,
but should my son Thomas die without heir lawfully begotten of his
body then & in that case the Heires, Sons and Daughters above mentioned to him
to be equally divided among all my surviving Children, otherwise to
him, his Heires and Assigns for ever
And the residue of my Estate of what kind soever to be sold & all
my just Debts paid, & the remainder of the profits arising from the sale
with what Money, Estates & accounts to be collected to be equally di-
vided among all my surviving Daughters
Item, I hereby make, constitute & appoint my son Isaac Simmon
and my son in law Richard Morris Executors of this my last Will and
Testament, hereby revoking and making void all writing thereto by me
made, ratifying & confirming this the no other
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand before this 3d day
of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & six

I, Edmund Simmon of the County of Hance & State of North Carolina
being of good & perfect mind & memory do this Twenty ninth day of December
begun the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred & six make & establish
this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following
Item, I give & bequeath to my beloved wife one Horse named Jack
Two Cows & Calf, one pair of Sheep, & sufficient
quantity of provisions for her support for one year, one new feather Bed
all my Slave & Cotton that are on Hand also all my Sea water to her & her
servants for ever
also send my wife during her natural life
two Negroes named Jim & Hannah & part of my Plantation wherein
now lies from a Pitch that is on the south side of this house to the North
including the dwelling house & all the out houses & orchards & the timber
adjoining to maintain the same, one pair of fine toys, all my Chairs made
earlier, two iron pots, one large, the other small, of old chaires to lean
on the premises, but if not, then give unto my wife in the time of her
plantation & furniture one hundred & twenty Dollars to be paid her in cash
by my executors
also lend my wife two cows & pigs & one sheep
during her natural life
Item, I give bequeath unto my son, Nathaniel Simmon all my
lands, except one piece on the South side of Morris' branch to Richard
cornet Park, also all the Negroes he has now in his possession that I have
a right to, one half of my Stock of cattle that is, that is not particularly
mention'd in bequests thereafter, also all the property that I have left my
wife after her decease of ransome except the two Negroes Jim & Hannah
are one large Table, some candlesticks, also one half of my Stock of Sheep,
to him, his Heires and Assigns for ever
Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Murnford one
half of my Stock of Sheep, also one hundred Dollars in Money, to her and
her Heirs, also give said Elizabeth one Black Horse named Star
to her a Negro boy for ever
also the London daughter Elizabeth
Murnford during her natural life three Negroes named Peter, Justice
& John, also the other Negro named Jim after the death of my wife
Item, I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Anna Simmon
one half of my son John Simmons wife Agnes & her grand daughter
Dollars in Money to them, their Heires or survivors. Also I give unto
Peter Simmon, one feather Bed to her and her Heir
Item, I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Abdiel Simmon one hundred
Dollars, to him and his Heires or Assigns
Item, I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Prudence Morris
one half of a Negro boy named Rich, also fifty Dollars in Money, also
two Cows, together his Heires and Assigns
Item, I give & bequeath unto my Grand daughter Anna Simmon
the other half of Anna's bed, one black Mare called Rose, two Cows & Calf
and forty Dollars in Money to her & her Heires & Assigns
Item, I give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Anna Simmon
one Negro Girl named Hannah after the death of my wife to her Heires
& in case of her death before her arrival of Agnes marriage to her
Brothers and Sisters of the whole blood
Item, I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Anna Simmon
one Land beginning at a Cypress Stake where the fence crosses Morris' branch
there with the fence south 35 West to the Spring Road, thence
with the road to the Mill run, then up the Run to the back line of John
Simmon's patent, then with the patent line to the Mill run, then the boundary
of his line to an Oak on a Hanes' branch, then down the Waters of
Hanes to the beginning, to him, his Heires and Assigns for ever
Item, I give and bequeath unto my five grand children, sons & daughters
of Edmund Hatch one hundred & twenty five Dollars, to them and their
Heires or survivors in case of death before their arrival of age
TEN' out
