Wood all the residue of my estate whatsoever, both real
or kind it may be during her natural life and after
her decease to be sold and equally divided among all
my children, namely as follows, James, F. by, John,
Trany, Mary, Nephew, Senna, Aaron & Isaiah.
I hereby nominate constitute & appoint my wife
Elizabeth Wood & my son L. Wood executors to this
my last Will & Testament hereby revoking & disannulling
all other Wills by me heretofore made. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this day
and year within written in
Saguna Lake published and declared
in the presence of us who have

5th I give devise & bequeath to my sister David
Bunker one Shilling Sterling to her her Heirs
and assigns for ever
6th I give and bequeath unto my sister Minny
Herrit one Shilling Sterling to her her Heirs and
assigns for ever
7th I give & bequeath to my nephew
Lewis Morris one Shilling Sterling to him his
Heirs and assigns for ever
Lastly, I hereby revoke all other Wills by me made
acknowledging this to be my last Will & Testament
