

or personal it may be during her natural life and after
her decease to be sold and equally divided among all
my children, namely as follows, James, Eliza, John,
Franky, Mary, Nelly, Anna, Aaron & Isiah.
I hereby nominate constitute & appoint my wife
Elizabeth Knox & my son Jno. Wood executors to the
my last will & Testament hereby revoking & desencting
all other Wills by me heretofore made. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day
and year written written in
Sugne before published and delivered
in the presence for and as his last Will
& Testament in presence of us who have
hereunto subscribed as witnesses —

Remey all my Estate both real & personal (Except
what I shall hereafter bequeath) to him his
Heirs and assigns for ever —
4th I give devise and bequeath to my
sister Susannah Remey one Shilling Sterling
to her her heirs and assigns for ever —
5th I give devise & bequeath to my sister Civil
Dunkin one Shilling Sterling to her her Heirs
and assigns for ever —
6th I give and bequeath unto my sister Minerva
Harriet one Shilling Sterling to her her Heirs and
assigns for ever —
7th I give & bequeath to my nephew
Lewis Morris one Shilling Sterling to him his
Heirs and assigns for ever —
Lastly, I hereby revoke all other Wills by me made
acknowledging this to be my last Will & Testament

of homespun Cloth to her & her heirs forever -

Lastly I leave unto my daughter Francis (33)
Gray during her Natural life all the residue and
remainder of my Estate of what kind or denomina-
tion soever, and at my said daughters death
my Will & desire is that it shall be equally divided
among all her Children to them & their heirs
for ever - And further I do appoint my
son Jonathan Hay Executor and my daughter
Frances Councillor to this my last Will and
