 of our Lord 1804 appointed & constituted Edward Simmons,
 Joseph Lander & George Westbrook Executors my Executors
 to carry this last Will & Testament into execution; they being
 vested with such power as in all cases requires. I will
 that my Executors keep my three lots in the plantation
 or go in any manner they shall think proper until the payment
 of all my debts, & then to go as hereafter mentioned.
 I give & bequeath to Amos W. Simmons & Joseph
 Simmons a tract on North side of Great Road Easterly of
 a line beginning on the River at the log landing, running
 Northerly on a straight line to my back, (which line shall
 be run & marked by my Executors, & be so accustomed as to
 run one hundred & fifty yards to the Eastward of Duwick's
 fence) thence Easterly with my out line to the River, thence
 up the same to the beginning.
 I give to J. Bay Jr. & Edward Mumford all my lands in
 Craven with this restriction; that if Edward dies before he
 arrives of lawful age, having no lawful issue, then his
 part to descend to Frederick, in order to exclude the half
 blood on the father's side.
 I give to Lavender Simmons one Negro Man & assat, to
 have full possession immediately after my debts are paid.
 I give to Needham Simmons all my Estate both real &
 personal which have not already been given away by the
 preceding clauses of this Will.

 Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Hazard thirty two & three quarters Acres of land which I hold in my own right in Jones County, to her, her Heirs & Assigns for ever. I also give unto my said Daughter Mary Hazard as she now wisheth, a young horse, a cow & yearling, the whole of my Stock of Hens, two feather Beds, Bedsteads & furniture, a Loom & Loom, a Wheel Cards, also the remainder of my household & Kitchen furniture, also the whole of my plantation Utensils, the whole of my wearing Apparel, also the whole of my out standing debts as well as what I may have by me, to her, her Heirs & Assigns for ever.
 Item I give & bequeath unto my son George Crutchfield, Richard Crutchfield, Philip Crutchfield & James Will, each one Shilling Sterling, of my Estate & no more, to them, their Heirs & Assigns for ever.
 Lastly I nominate & appoint my friend John Morrison, & my Daughter Mary & Edward Executors to this my last Will & Testament, disannulling all former Wills by me made, satisfying & confirming this only as my last Will & Testament.
